

**RAYMOND BOARD OF SELECTMEN PUBLIC HEARING MINUTES 04-12-04**  
**Approved 5-3-04**

The meeting was called to order on April 12, 2004, at the Town Office at 7:00 p.m. by Chairman Jonathan Wood. Members present: Norman Weldy, Paul Brown, Jack Barnes and Jonathan Wood. Also present: Town Manager Richard Bates, Dennis Tewksbury, Consultant and members of the Hilltop Cooperative.

**PUBLIC HEARING**

Dennis Tewksbury presented the Board with a package outlining the need for a CBDG Hilltop Cooperative feasibility study for Englewood Trailer Park in Raymond. Additionally in the process, the water system and septic system improvements for the Park, might include surface water drainage improvements. This feasibility study needs to be approved and submitted by the Town of Raymond on behalf of the Hilltop Cooperative. Mr. Tewksbury explained the process and the need for the Displacement and Relocation Plan and Community Development Plan to be reaffirmed as was done in 2000 for the Pennichuck Water System improvements.

There were various comments in favor of the proposal and there being no further comments, Chairman Jonathan Wood closed the Public Hearing portion of the meeting.

**Motion by Selectman Dick Wood to affirm the Town's Housing and Community Development Plan and the Displacement and Relocation Plan.**

**Selectman Norm Weldy seconded the motion. Voted unanimously.**

Town Manager Bates is asked to get the documents ready for the Selectmen's signature.

**Motion by Selectman Jack Barnes that the Town of Raymond submit an application to the New Hampshire Office of Community Development Finance Authority in the amount of \$12,000 for a CDBG feasibility study grant for improvements to Hilltop Cooperative water and wastewater treatment systems at no cost to the Town.**

**Selectman Norm Weldy seconded the motion. Voted unanimously.**

**Selectman Dick Wood moves that the Selectmen authorize Town Manager Bates to sign the Application.**

**Selectman Norm Weldy seconded the motion. Voted unanimously.**

**Adjournment**

**Motion by Selectman Paul Brown for adjournment. Selectman Jack Barnes seconded. Voted unanimously.**
